**DESCRIPTION:**

This notice of competition applies to the Assistant Professor/ Adjunct (research and teaching position) at the Institute of Cultural Sciences of the Kazimierz Wielki University.

The candidate is expected to meet the following requirements:

- to hold a doctoral degree in Humanities in the field of Culture Studies or Literary Studies or an equivalent degree (if it is obtained abroad it should meet the degree equivalence requirements specified in Art.326, Art.327 or Art. 328 of the Law on Higher Education and Science of 20 July 2018, and in particular, the candidate's recognition procedures should be completed upon documents' submission)
- to submit a declaration on representing the discipline of *Culture and Religion Studies* or – if the candidate has not submitted such a declaration yet – a committed promise to submit this declaration in the event of employment
- to have research and academic output in Culture and Religion Studies or related disciplines (Arts Studies, Literary Studies) that fulfills the requirements stipulated in the University Charter, Article 104, Section 2, Subsection 1)
- to be proficient in German, which is certified by a university graduation diploma in German studies or a certificate of proficiency at the C2 level compliant with the requirements stipulated in the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages or throughout an assessment in German language conducted by the board appointed by competition committee, to which the candidate is providing his consent to by submitting his/her application.
- to have very good knowledge of the culture of German-speaking countries
- if the candidate is a foreign national, the basic knowledge of Polish is required

The scope of duties of the newly employed Assistant Professor covers:

- conducting research in Culture and Religion Studies
- publishing at least 4 publications within 4 years (monographs, chapters in journals or edited volumes) that can be considered in the quality assessment of research activity
- conducting courses in first-cycle and second-cycle studies, including courses in German
- accomplishing other tasks that result from the employment-related duties

Required documents:

- 1) application for employment as Assistant Professor (research and teaching position) addressed to the Rector of the Kazimierz Wielki University
- 2) Academic CV and a cover letter
- 3) Personal data form (Attachment 1)
- 4) Photograph
- 5) Copies of documents certifying the professional degree, academic degree and academic title
- 6) A document confirming perfect command of German language or a declaration of consent to engage in an exam confirming language proficiency (Attachment 2) - not applicable for a graduates of German philology / German studies
- 7) Copies of employment certificates from past employments
- 8) Declaration that the Kazimierz Wielki University will be the primary employer of the university lecturer/ academic (Attachment 3)
- 9) Declaration that the candidate meets the requirements under Article 113 of the Law on Higher Education and Science of 20 July 2018 (Attachment 4)
- 10) Declaration of the candidate that s/he is aware of criminal liability for fraudulent certification of an untrue statement (Art. 233 of the Criminal Code) (Attachment 5)
- 11) Declaration of consent to be included in the overall number of employees conducting research activity and representing the discipline of Culture and Religion Studies (Attachment 6)
- 12) Certificates and information confirming the fulfillment of requirements specified in the notice of competition
  - List of publications and other academic achievements
  - Information on the participation in academic conferences
  - Information on ongoing research projects and applications for research grants
  - Information on teaching and organisational achievements
- 13) Declaration of consent to the processing of personal data for the needs of the selection process procedures (Attachment 7)

All the documents should be written in Polish or translated into Polish.
