KEYWORDS: assistant professor (adjunct), WNoZiKF, UKW, health sciences, physical culture sciences (sport sciences).

DESCRIPTION: the contest concerns the position of assistant professor for research and teaching at the Faculty of Health Sciences and Physical Education. The candidate should have a doctoral degree and represent health sciences and/or physical culture sciences (sport sciences). Have competences to teach subjects including: General physiotherapy, Research methodology, Fundamentals of physical therapy.

It is assumed that there can be an interview with the candidates.

Candidates applying for employment as assistant professor for research and teaching should meet the conditions set out in the Act of 20 July 2018 Law on Higher Education (Journal of Laws of 2022, item 574, as amended) and in the Statute of the Kazimierz Wielki University in Bydgoszcz and meet the following requirements:

1. Have a doctoral degree in physical culture sciences (sport sciences) and/or health sciences.
2. Have a license to practice as a physiotherapist.
3. Be characterized by scientific activity confirmed by scientific achievements.

4. Have competences within the scope of expertise in physiotherapy, e.g. neurological, orthopedic or other.
5. Have academic and didactic experience.
6. Have a diploma/certificates of a therapist, e.g. PNF and BOBATH methods.
7. Experience in managing the rehabilitation process and a team of physiotherapists.
8. Have knowledge of English at least at an intermediate level.
9. The foreign candidate is required to have documented knowledge of the Polish language at an advanced level (C1).

The candidate's additional advantages will include:

1. Inter-sectoral cooperation and development of preventive health care programs.
2. Organization of workshops and conferences on prevention and rehabilitation.
3. Other documented activities/experience in the field of physiotherapy.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:

A candidate applying for the position of assistant professor for research and teaching is required to submit the following documents:

1. Application addressed to the Rector.
2. CV and cover letter.
3. Personal questionnaire, attached as Appendix 1 to ordinance. 43/2018/2019 of the Rector of the Kazimierz Wielki University of June 14, 2019.
4. Photo.
5. Document confirming obtaining a professional title, academic degree, license to practice as a physiotherapist, additional education.
6. Copies of employment certificates from terminated employment relationships.
7. Declaration that in the event of employment, the Kazimierz Wielki University will be the primary place of work of an academic teacher, on the template constituting Appendix 2 to the ordinance no. 43/2018/2019 of the Rector of the Kazimierz Wielki University of June 14, 2019.
8. Documents confirming the fulfilment of the additional requirements specified in the competition announcement.
9. Statement on meeting the requirements of art. 113 of the Act of July 20, 2019. The Law on Higher Education and Science, on the template constituting Appendix 3 to ordinance no. 43/2018/2019 of the Rector of the Kazimierz Wielki University of June 14, 2019.
10. Declaration of awareness of criminal liability related to certifying untruths (Article 233 of the Penal Code) on the template constituting Appendix 4 to the ordinance no. 43/2018/2019 of the Rector of the Kazimierz Wielki University of June 14, 2019.

All documents should be prepared or translated into Polish.

Documents confirming obtaining a professional title, academic degree, academic title or equivalent, obtained abroad, should meet the equivalence requirements specified in art. 326, art. 327 or article. 328 of the Act of 20

July 2018 Law on Higher Education and Science, in particular, at the time of submitting the documents, the candidate's nostrification procedure should be completed.

Documents submitted or sent after the submission deadline will not be considered. The date of the postmark determines the validity of the sending.

The University reserves the right not to settle the competition without giving a reason. The result of the competition is not tantamount to employment of the candidate, but is only a recommendation for the Rector. The final decision on employment is made by the Rector.
